## Data Collection with Survey123



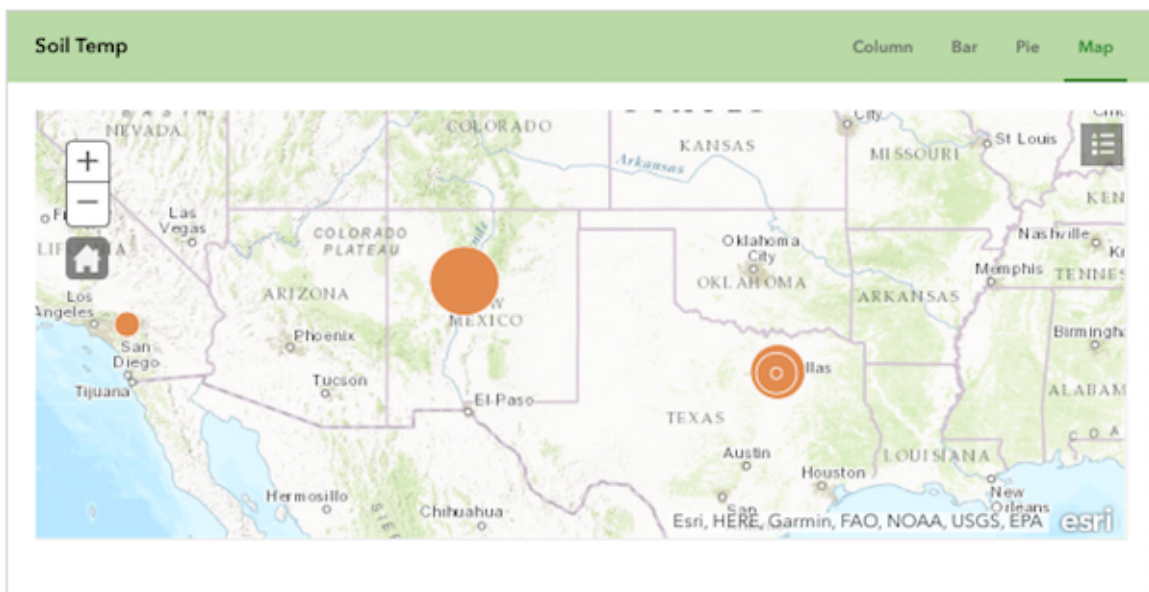

Here is what it takes:

- An ArcGIS Online account. [MBED](#) provides these for teachers and students. (free)
- Survey123 for ArcGIS - A web app for creating surveys. Get it at the bottom of this [page](#). (free)
- A smartphone with the Survey123 for ArcGIS mobile app installed to collect the data. (The app is free)

Data collected is immediately available on a map. Here is an example that may peak your interest.

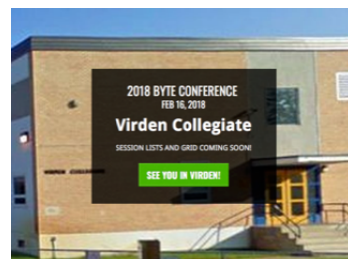
## Byte Conference 2018
